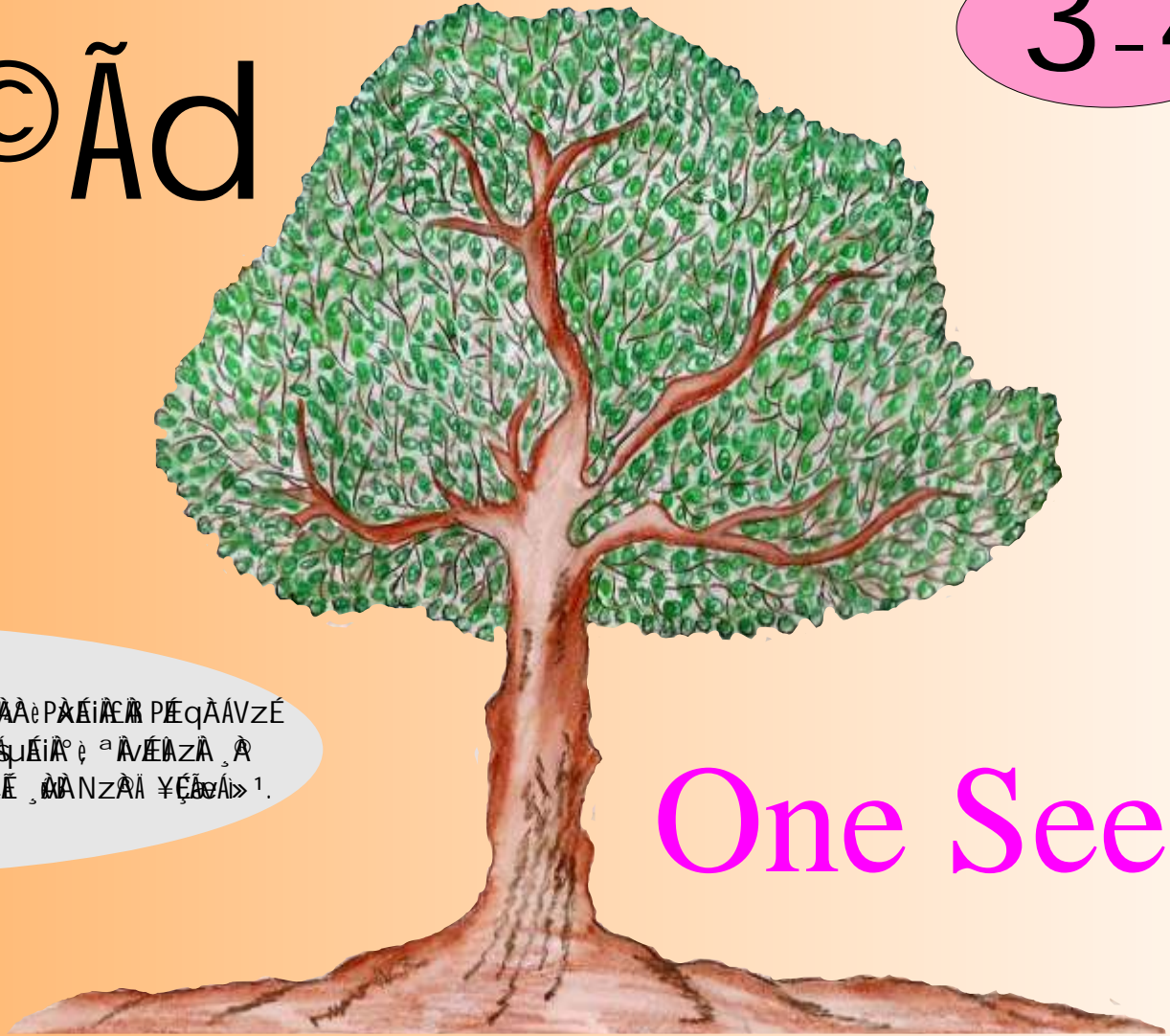

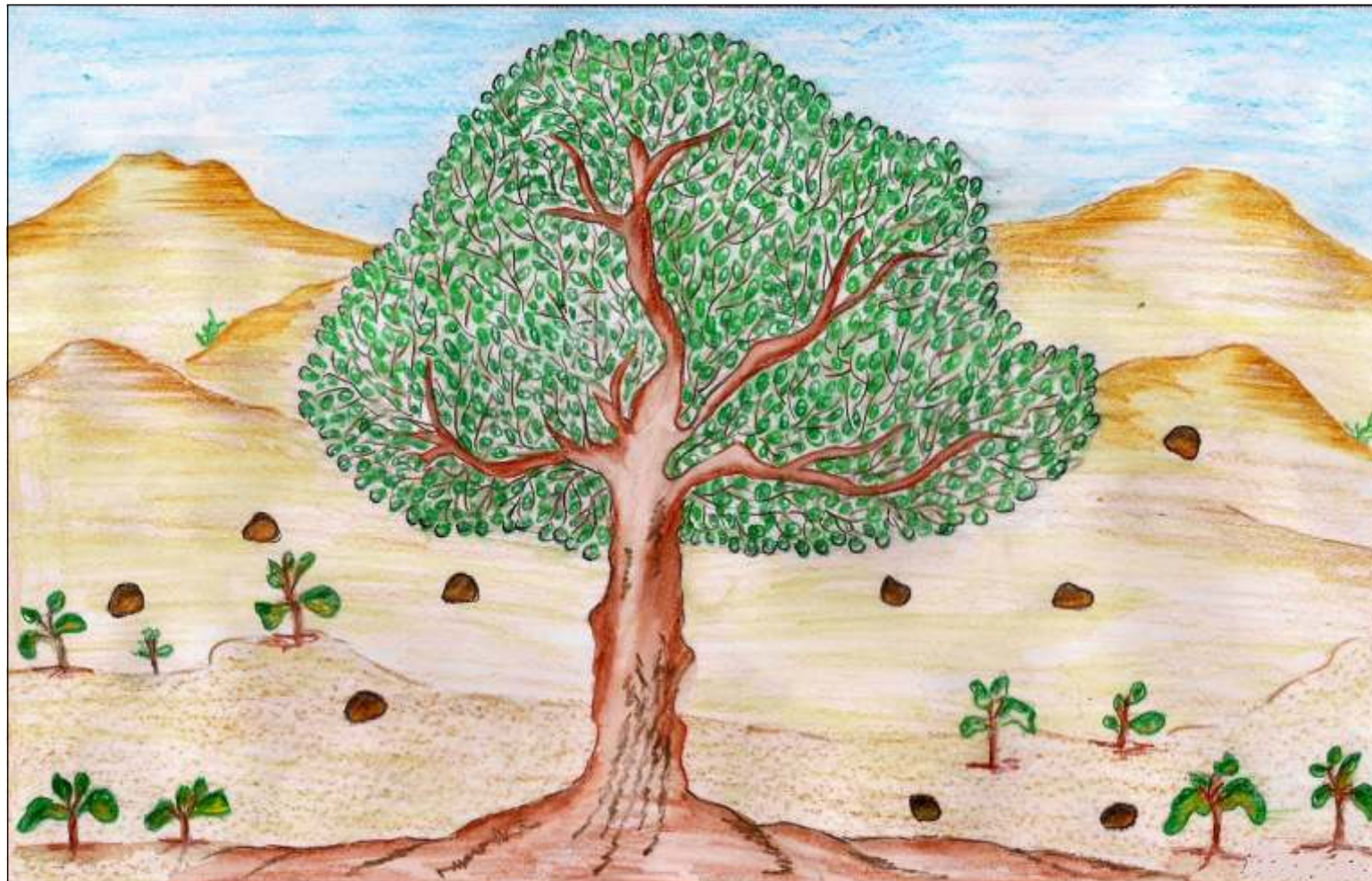
One Seed
